The application recently mailed to you did not include portions of Block C (questions 1 and 2) that are required to be completed for renewal of your permit.

Enclosed is page 2 of the Application for Federal Fisheries Permit. **Please complete Block C and return this page with the remaining completed pages of the Federal Fisheries Permit application** to renew your FFP for the period beginning January 1, 2012.
